Only one (1) Flotilla will be considered from Each District (Regions, i.e., ER, WR) are considered separate Auxiliary Districts) and that flotilla must be **recommended by the District Commodore**. The recommendation must be made on this form to the **NATIONAL AWARDS CHAIR, COMO Richard B. Miller, Pres. NAPDIC, 5200 Irving Boulevard Sp-316, Irvine, CA 92620-2057.** *Forms must arrive on or before 1 June, 2005. Please include the flotilla end or year 2004 AUXMIS Report.*

The recommended flotilla MUST have a minimum of **10** members on 31 Dec. 2005. Flotillas with waivers for ANY reason are NOT eligible. The flotilla with the greatest number of points shall be the winner. In case of a tie, the flotilla with the greatest *percent*, as determined by these calculations, of its membership qualified as VE's/MV's shall be the winner.
