OPERATIONAL DRESS UNIFORM (ODU) SALE

ALCOAST 381/08 announces a Four-for-One sale for the current tucked ODUs.

1. To pave the way for the un-tucked version of the ODU, the UDC is offering **certain** sizes of the current ODU at four for the price of one. Inventory levels of certain sizes must be liquidated to make it possible to stock the un-tucked ODU scheduled for delivery in Fall 2008.
2. The UDC is the only ordering site for this sale. Orders may be placed via the [UDC Webstore](#), fax, phone, or order by mail. No other ordering sites or Coast Guard Exchanges will honor this sale.
3. The present ODU may be worn as long as it is in good, serviceable condition until 31 December 2012.

NOTE: When you place an order for one of the sale sizes of ODU's, you will see ONE on your invoice copy at the regular price, but will automatically be shipped FOUR of that particular size (e.g., pay for one OC32L and be shipped four OC32L's). The non-invoiced ODUS will have an identifying mark on the size tag to prevent erroneous returns.

The [Return Policy](#) will remain the same for this sale. If you need to return or exchange a purchase made under this sale, ALL FOUR of the same-sized items will need to be returned. To return or exchange, please include a readable copy of your invoice and the completed [UDC Returns Form](#)  for consideration.

The sizes (subject to change **without notice**) that are available at 4-for-1 are indicated in **RED** on the [ODU Uniforms](#) page.
