

Using J-Initiator with Windows XP and IE7.

You should be using J-Initiator 1.3.1.22

If you cannot get AUXDATA reports, it's because they come up via a Pop-up. First do the following which will cause IE7, when it sees the site "*.uscg", to switch to Trusted Sites.

1. Go to Tools\Internet\Options,
2. Select the "Security" tab and then the "Trusted Sites",
3. Add "*.uscg.gov" and "*.uscg.mil" into the "Trusted Sites",
Uncheck the box about https to be able to add these
4. Then select the "Custom Level" button and
Scroll down to section Active X controls, then to
 - Download signed Active X controls and change the P to E
5. Enable Active-X Controls,
6. "Launch programs and frames in an IFRAME" and disable popup blocker.
Scroll down to Miscellaneous, then down to
 - Launching program and files to IFRAME, change the P to E
 - Use Pop-up Blocker and change the E to D

Once you have done this, also make sure you do not have any other Pop-Up blockers. These are being installed with various Toolbars (ie Google) and security programs.

INSTALLING CITRIX

There are many questions about getting CITRIX, and installing it on your pc. If you are running Vista, you must have the latest Citrix.

If you have Citrix installed, use control panel, Add/Remove Programs and Delete it.
